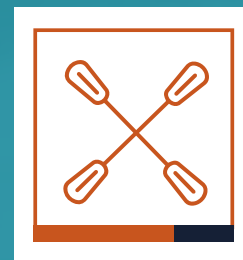

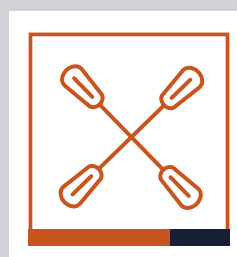

WHAT ARE THE DIFFERENCES BETWEEN 'FULLY CATERED' AND 'EXPEDITION' MODES?



The Fully Catered mode is a 100% fully supported trip. We'll have a support motor boat that will accompany us throughout the journey. All you'll need to do is paddle from one beach to another and set up your tent, where delicious meals, cold drinks, shade, and a ready-made camp will be waiting for you to continue enjoying.



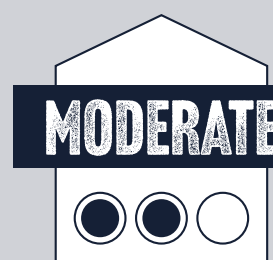
The Expedition mode is pure adventure. We load ALL the equipment onto our kayaks and work together to set up the kitchen, assemble the camp, and prepare delicious local dishes. On this trip, we won't have a support motor boat—just us, the guide, and the kayaks.

PHYSICAL LEVELS



Suitable for all healthy people who engage in physical activity.

- Physical activity per day: 3 – 5 hours.
- Trip duration: 2 – 4 days.



Suitable for all healthy people who engage in regular physical activity.

- Physical activity per day: 3 – 5 hours.
- Trip duration: 4 – 7 days.



Suitable for people who are physically active and have some experience in kayaking.

- Physical activity per day: 6 – 8 hours.
- Trip duration: 7 to 11 days.

KAYAK LEVELS:



Location	Coastal waters with easy access to sheltered areas.
Distance per day	8-10 km (5-6 millas)
Recommended kayak skills	No prior skills required.
Trip mode	Fully catered.



Location	Coastal waters with easy-to-access shelters.
Distance per day	8-15 km (5-9 millas)
Recommended kayak skills	No prior skills required.
Trip mode	Expedition.



Location	Coastal waters with limited access to sheltered areas.
Distance per day	15-20 km (9-12 millas)
Recommended kayak skills	Good balance. Paddling knowledge helps.
Trip mode	Expedition.

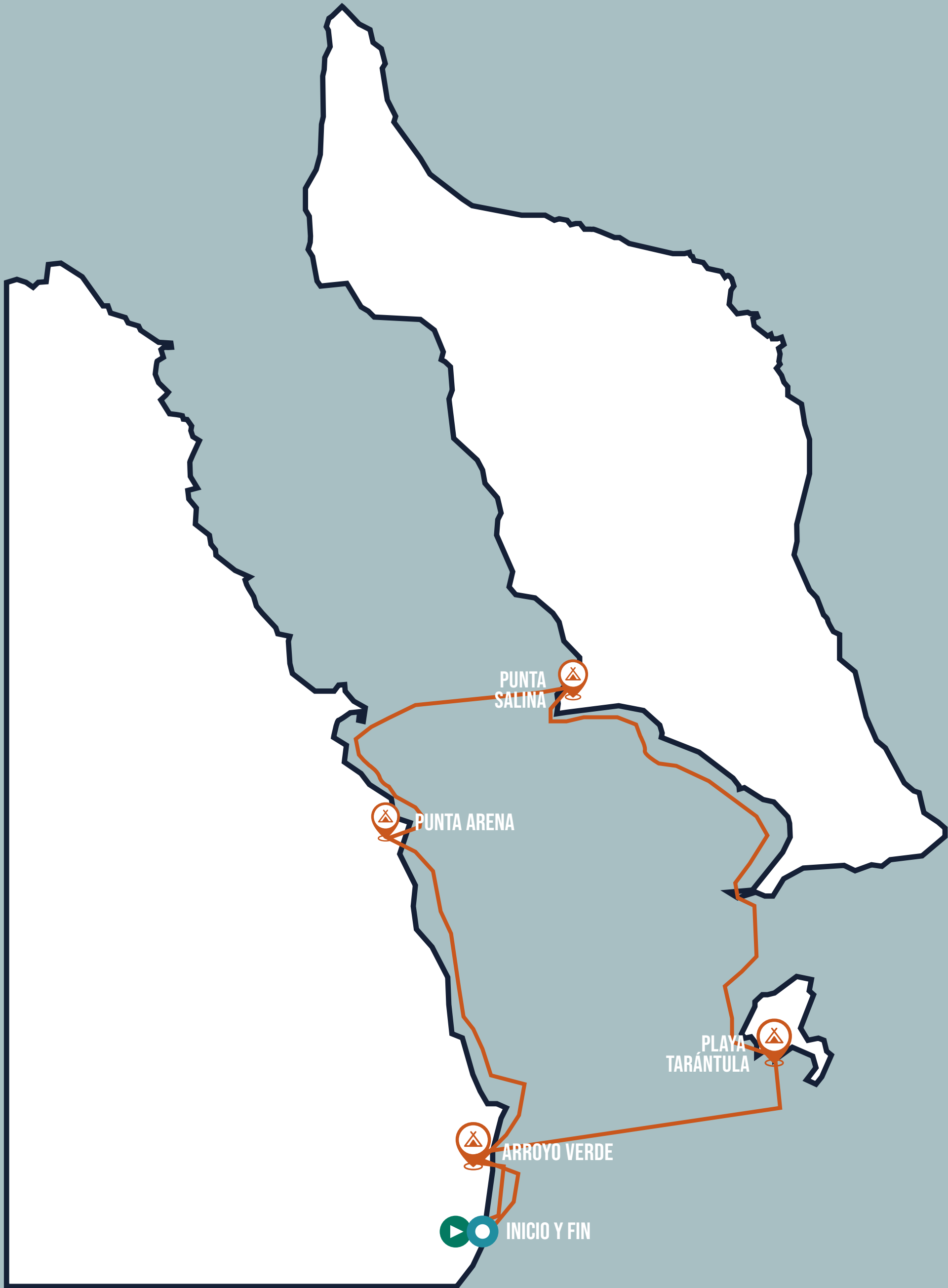

ITINERARY

DAY 0

On this day, you will check in at the hotel. You can enjoy the city of La Paz throughout the day. In the evening, we will meet in the hotel lobby with your guide(s) to clarify any doubts and prepare for the next day.

DAY 1

After breakfast at the hotel, we will gear up and drive to the starting point: Playa el Portugués. Before we start paddling, we will prepare the kayaks and familiarize ourselves with them by practicing some safety measures. After a light lunch, we will begin the first paddle towards Arroyo Verde, where we will set up camp with a view of the Sea of Cortés and the Sierra la Giganta.





DAY 2

We will wake up with coffee and a hearty breakfast to fuel up for our first open water crossing to Isla San Francisco. This remote island features white sand bays and a perfect marine ecosystem for snorkeling. In the afternoon, we will hike to the highest point of the island to get a panoramic view of the Sea of Cortés. We will end the day watching the sunset with a margarita in hand.

DAY 3

On this day, we will paddle between the different islands of the archipelago. Starting from Isla San Francisco, we will head towards El Islote el Pardito, famous for the local fishing community. If weather conditions allow, we can stop to have lunch there or buy fresh fish, which we can enjoy at our next camp. We will then continue crossing to Isla San José, passing through a mangrove channel with diverse flora and fauna. We will keep paddling until we reach our camp at Punta Salina, where we will close the day with a delicious dinner.

DAY 4

On this day, we will make the final open water crossing to the coast, which typically takes a couple of hours. Once we complete the crossing, we will be rewarded with a delightful lunch in the picturesque community of San Evaristo. After recharging our energy, we will paddle to Punta Arenas, where we will spend the night.



DAY 5

We will continue paddling along the coast until we reach Arroyo Verde, a beach known for its coral reefs and excellent snorkeling spots. We will spend the afternoon exploring the sea, followed by the last “Happy Hour” and the final night of the expedition.

DAY 6

We will paddle back to Playa el Portugués, where we began. Our transportation will be waiting for us to take us back to La Paz with lunch and refreshing beverages. Once we return to La Paz, we can finally shower at the hotel. In the evening, we will have a final dinner with the whole group and our guides to share stories and say goodbye with a toast.

PAYMENT, REFUND, AND CANCELLATION POLICY:

RESERVATIONS AND DEPOSITS:

Deposit: To confirm a spot on any of our trips, the client must make a deposit of 50% of the total price.

- Full Payment: The total amount must be paid 60 days prior to the trip departure date.
- If the client books within 60 days of the trip departure date, the full payment required for the service must be made at the time of booking.

REFUNDS AND CANCELLATIONS:

- 100% Refund: If the client cancels the reservation 2 months before the trip departure date, INDÔMITO will issue a 100% refund of the amount paid, minus an administrative fee of \$2,000 MXN per person.
- 50% Refund: If the client cancels the reservation 1 month before the trip departure date, INDÔMITO will issue a 50% refund of the amount paid.
- No Refund: No refunds will be issued for cancellations made within the month prior to the trip departure.

TRIP CANCELLATION:

In the unlikely event that INDÔMITO cancels a trip due to a lack of participants or due to unforeseen circumstances, the client will be notified 1 month before the trip departure date. In this case, INDÔMITO will issue a full refund of the amount paid. INDÔMITO is not responsible for expenses incurred in trip preparation, such as non-refundable flight tickets, personal equipment purchases, etc.





PORT CLOSURE:

We understand that weather conditions can be unpredictable, and the safety of our travelers is our priority. If the Port Authority of La Paz decides to close the port due to adverse weather conditions before or during your experience, we will adjust the itinerary to ensure your safety, either by advancing or delaying the start or end of the trip. INDÔMITO will cover an additional night of accommodation and the corresponding meals to ensure you are well taken care of. If it becomes necessary to extend the stay beyond one night due to the same cause, we unfortunately will not be able to cover these additional costs, but we will be happy to assist you with the logistics.

INDÔMITO highly recommends purchasing travel insurance in case the trip needs to be canceled due to unforeseen circumstances.
